

GUIDELINE 1.2 - GUIDELINE DECISIONS OF THE AUSTRALIAN RESUSCITATION COUNCIL

Guideline

- 1. It is the policy of the Australian Resuscitation Council that the autonomy of member organisations is respected.
- 2. Guidelines of the Australian Resuscitation Council regarding resuscitation will be made:
 - according to an approved process (Guideline 1.3);
 - to foster the Council's objectives in promoting simplicity and uniformity in resuscitation techniques and terminology regarding resuscitation;
 - after consideration of all available scientific evidence and other information. They do not necessarily imply that other methods are ineffective.
