ARC Advanced Life Support Level 2

The Australian Resuscitation Council Advanced Life Support Level 2 is a standardised national course for healthcare professionals. All applicants must hold a professional healthcare qualification and current clinical or healthcare educational appointment. This course is very intense and prior clinical knowledge and experience of critically ill patients is essential.

Course Features:
