GUIDELINE DECISIONS OF THE AUSTRALIAN RESUSCITATION COUNCIL

1. It is the policy of the Australian Resuscitation Council that the autonomy of member organisations is respected.
2. Guidelines of the Australian Resuscitation Council regarding resuscitation will be made:
 - according to an approved process (Guideline 1.3);
 - to foster the Council's objectives in promoting simplicity and uniformity in resuscitation techniques and terminology regarding resuscitation;
 - after consideration of all available scientific evidence and other information. They do not necessarily imply that other methods are ineffective.
